A recent survey of people out of work analyzed the type of worker who is unemployed. Out of all those registered as unemployed a minority were women. The majority of men who were unemployed were found in services and engineering. However, the chance of being unemployed was also likely in the constructions industry. There was some unemployment in industries such as metal goods and textiles.

If somebody was unemployed from engineering, mining or chemicals, he could usually find another job. However, an unemployed person from agriculture or construction seldom found a job again. Job chances were generally much better for manual workers than for office workers.

Most of the unemployed had been without jobs for more than two months. A number of these had been unemployed for more than a year. Undoubtedly the longer a person is out of work, the more likely it is that he will not find another job. In addition, job prospects are definitely worse for older workers.
